SUMMER SCHOOL 2016 REGISTRATION INFORMATION

San Lorenzo Valley High School

Registration Information

- The summer school/credit recovery program is available to eligible students who need to recover credits towards graduation or to stay on track for UC/CSU eligibility.
- Priority will be given to students who have failed a previous course with an "F" or "D" grade.
- Please see your student's guidance counselor for additional information about the summer credit recovery program.
- The deadline for submitting registration requests will be **Friday, May 20 to your counselor.**
- Credit Recovery classes are **not** open to out of district students or incoming 9th grade students.
- *PE Course 1 (one semester) is available to **eligible 8th graders.**
- Each class is worth 5 semester credits. 4 weeks = 1 semester course.

Course Information

The following courses will be offered in the Credit Recovery program this summer:

- Math 1** provides students the opportunity to study concepts of algebra, geometry, functions, number and operations, statistics and modeling throughout the course. These concepts include expressions in the real number system, creating and reasoning with equations and inequalities, interpreting and building simple functions, expressing geometric properties and interpreting categorical and quantitative data. (May count for semester 1 or 2 and 5 math credits.)
- Math 2** continues a progression of the standards established in Math 1. In addition to these standards, Math 2 includes: polynomials, congruence and similarity of figures, trigonometry with triangles, modeling with geometry, probability, making inferences and justifying conclusions. (May count for semester 1 or 2 and 5 math credits.)
- Math 3** progresses from the standards learned in Math 1 and Math 2. In addition to these standards, Math 3 extends to include algebraic concepts such as: the complex number system, inverse functions, trigonometric functions and the unit circle. Math 3 also includes the geometric concepts of conics and circles. (May count for semester 1 or 2 and 5 math credits.)
- On-line Credit Recovery** (On-line curriculum--*Counselor will work with student in selecting course. Students will earn 5 subject-specific credits.)
- PE Course 1 or 2 (Semester 1 or 2):** Topics will include setting health and fitness goals, individual and team sports, cross fit and weight training. (Students qualify if they earned an "F" and must recover the credits for one semester in either PE Course 1 or 2. Students who are enrolled in AVID 9 or 10, or in EL / Reading Support, Directed Studies or one of the Career Pathways programs may take this summer PE course. Students will earn 5 PE credits.)
- Jumpstart Program:** An educational opportunity to prepare **middle school** students for a successful transition to high school. The program is designed to strengthen the skills of middle school students who fail to meet promotion standards, or for students who need extra support in order to access HS Math 1 as a freshman. While math will be the main academic focus, other academic disciplines will also be incorporated into the program. Academic success strategies, building motivation, and supporting students to fulfill their potential are key elements of the program.
